



GUIDANCE FOR LEARNING WHEN SELF-ISOLATING OR AWAITING TEST RESULTS

Please note that this will be under constant review by the Senior Leadership Team and is subject to change dependant on the circumstances in school

<u>Reason for not attending school</u>	<u>Parents and carers are asked to</u>	<u>School will</u>
My child is unwell – non Covid-19 symptoms	Telephone the school office to inform them that the child is unwell with non Covid-19 symptoms. Contact the school daily.	Mark in the register as absent and inform the class teacher as usual.
My child or a member of our household is exhibiting Covid-19 symptoms	Telephone the school office to inform that my child or a member of our household has Covid-19 symptoms . Keep my child at home and arrange a test as soon as possible. Keep any siblings at home following the government guidance. Email work to the class email address as I am able to. Contact the school daily.	Act on the Government advice which is to advise to self-isolate and get tested as soon as possible. The child/ren will be able to return to school if the test is negative. The office will inform the class teacher/s, who will then email work from the class email address by the end of the school day for the child to complete if they are well (minimum of two days' work following the class timetable). Parents/carers will be directed to the class page where there will be work (e.g. Fast Learning) that the child can complete until the teacher is able to email the directed work. The class teacher will provide feedback to the child via the class email. Please note that, as they are in class teaching, this will be sent after school. Teacher to make a check-in phone call if the child has been off for more than 4 days
My child's class is having to self-isolate due to a positive Covid-19 case in the class.	Follow the advice given by the school. Submit work to the class email address on behalf of my child.	Set work for the class via Google Classroom - if we have not completed the move to Google Classroom, then you will receive the work via email. The teacher will set: Maths, English and reading each day. Connected Curriculum e.g. science, art, history or geography, well-being activities, physical activities weekly. The class teacher will provide feedback to the child via Google Classroom- if we have not completed the move to Google Classroom, then you will receive the feedback via email. Teachers will be available via Google Classroom/class email and they will make telephone contact with parents/carers if required within usual school hours (9.00am – 3.30pm) For any children that require work to be printed, this will be posted at our earliest convenience.
