

Learners and Parents Live Interaction Agreement

As we continue to develop our online learning experience we will be including live interactions between teachers and their classes. With this development, there are additional expectations to ensure the safety of all users. Please read through the agreement below.

This agreement outlines what we expect of pupils and parents/carers during remote learning and what can be expected from us as a school.

Much of this echoes our Core Values when in school and all of it is designed to help pupils benefit the most from remote learning and keep our whole community safe.

We ask that Parents/Carers read the following information and then tick the box at the end to confirm they agree to this Remote Learning and Live Interaction Agreement. Blackwell Primary School will not be held responsible for any incidents that occur if the agreement has not been followed and will not permit any child to join any 'live' interactions if the agreement has not been signed by parents/carers.

The responsibility of the child and parents/ carers

- Myself and my parents/carers will check my Google Classroom account regularly to keep track of online sessions and learning – please note younger children may require some support.
- I understand that my teacher will only be available in usual schools hours between 9:00am and 3:30pm
- I will only use Google Meet as directed by the teacher and will only upload material that is related to my learning
- I understand that my parent/carer is responsible for Google Classroom login details and keeping these safe and that these are not to be shared with anyone.
- I will not use my Google Classroom login details to communicate with anyone other than my class teacher and ONLY when directed to do so by my teacher
- I will not take photos of my screen or record online interactions in any way
- I will make sure that my communication in the online learning is always supportive of my learning and the learning and wellbeing of others and shows the Core Values

If taking part in a live interaction

- My parent/carer is present in the room or in the next room with the door open so they can see and hear everything that is happening during the live session
- It is only the child that is visible on screen – no parents/carers should be visible
- my environment is quiet and free from distractions
- the background (and foreground) is appropriate and as neutral as possible (please be mindful of what is visible behind you/in front of you)
- I am appropriately dressed (e.g no pyjamas)
- I remain attentive
- I communicate in a courteous way showing the core values at all times to both teachers and fellow pupils
- I understand that the school will monitor my Google account to ensure everyone is kept safe.

- I will speak to an adult immediately if anything I see or hear when I am using Google Classroom makes me feel worried.

Parents and Carers

- Monitor my child's internet use and check that they are using technology safely and report any concerns to the school immediately
- Check my online protection systems to ensure their time online is as safe as possible
- Check that they understand the task they have been set. If not, I will give help and support as I am able to
- Make sure my child is sitting comfortably and in the correct position to learn
- Ensure that they have a suitable amount of time away from the screen during the day
- Discuss their work with them after they have completed it and any feedback they may have received as I am able to.
