Uniform expectations reminder.

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following our uniform reminder in July, we would like to extend our sincere thanks to all families who have supported the school by ensuring their children have started the year adhering to our uniform policy. It is greatly appreciated and contributes to a positive and focused learning environment for all.

Please could we ask that **each and every item of uniform and other items that come into school are clearly named**, this makes it so much easier to reunite with your child if it is mislaid.

However, we have noticed that a number of children are not meeting the expectations in some areas. Specifically, we are seeing:

- white soled or brightly coloured footwear that does not comply with our policy — all children should wear **completely black trainers or black shoes**.
- Jewellery or wristbands being worn — please can we remind you that **no jewellery of any kind** should be worn, with the exception of **small stud earrings** for pierced ears. These must be **removed or covered during PE lessons**.

We kindly ask for your continued support in ensuring your child follows these guidelines. Adhering to the uniform policy helps maintain consistency, safety, and a sense of pride across our school community.
