- Reading → Five times a week and record it in their diary.

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- Book that help your child read (scheme book) are based on their current reading performance and are sent home on Fridays.
- Over the week, please read with your child using the reading record
- As well as this scheme book, children can take a library book home to read
- Children can of course read freely at home on top of the scheme book. Try and encourage a varied diet of reading- fiction, non-fiction, information texts etc. You can sign up for e-books and activities www.oxfordowl.co.uk
