The 'Talk to Me' has been designed to inform you of what learning has been taught each week. We want to help you to further support your child's learning. Phonics

In Phonics this week we have been recapping the letter sounds (phonemes) that we have learnt so far. Please continue to practise these with your children at home. Perhaps you could point them out in the environment. **The phonemes we have learnt so far are: s a t p i n m d g o c k c k e u r ss.**

There are videos on our website under 'curriculum, phonics' which model the correct pronunciation of the sounds if you are unsure.

We have also learnt the harder to read and spell word pull.

Dojo challenge!

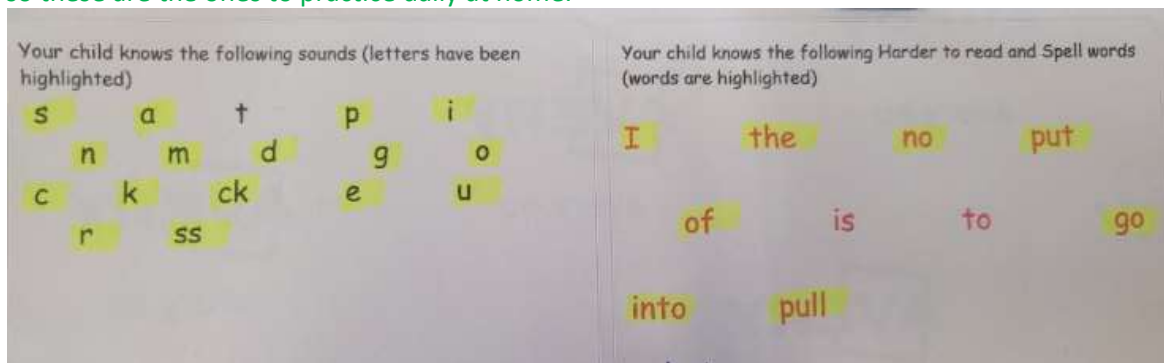
Can you find any of the phonemes we have learnt when you are out and about? Take some photos and upload to Tapestry. There may be some two or three letter words that you can read on signs in shops.

Flash card game idea

Look at the assessment sticker and remove all the sounds and harder to read and spell words that your child knows. Keep the ones they need to practice in the little coloured wallets so that you can just focus on these ones. Put them on the floor and jump on them to say them.

Phonics Assessment stickers

In your child's yellow reading record book you will find two stickers with the sounds and harder to read and spell words that your child knew highlighted. The ones not highlighted are the ones they did not know and so these are the ones to practice daily at home.



Maths

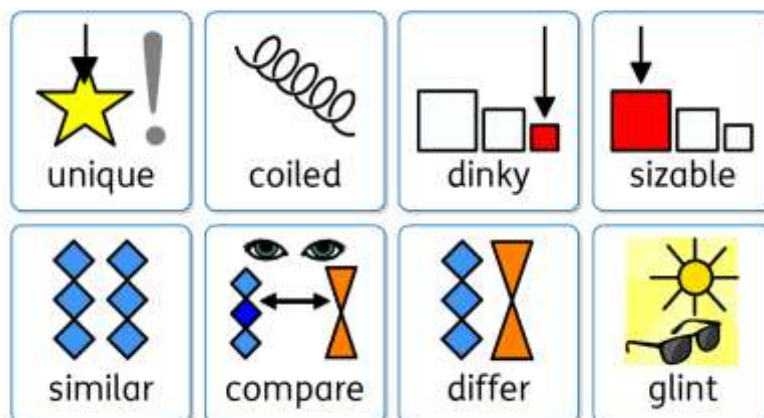
