Why don't you stick some of the flash cards on the wall at home and use your Nerf gun, a soft ball, a beanbag, a small teddy to hit them as you say them?

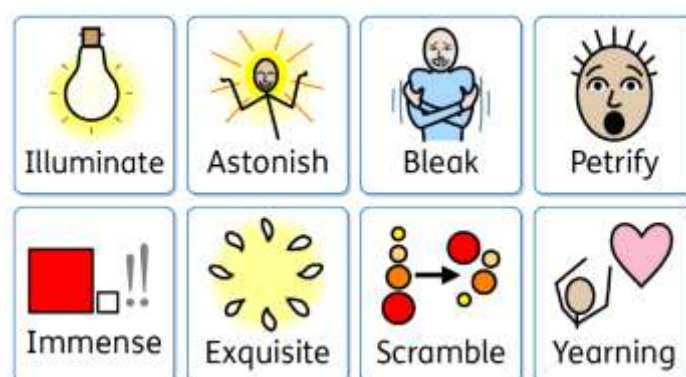
Maths

We have been thinking about the whole being bigger than its smaller parts. **Can you build something using parts to create a whole? Or perhaps you could complete a puzzle which is made up of parts to create a whole.**
