Phonics

This week, we have continued learning our letter sounds. We have learnt the letter sounds (phonemes) **h**, **b**, **l**, **ll**, and **f**, **ff**. **What words can you think of that have *these sounds in them*?**

Can you spot the graphemes (letters) that make this sound?

Can you 'robot talk' the words *doll, hill, puff and off*? Remember that *ll* and *ff* are digraphs and makes one sound!

We have also learnt the harder to read and spell words; **as** and **his**. **Can you find these words in your story book at bedtime?**

The half term challenge is to write your name 3 times everyday and be able to write your name by the time we come back to school. You can use the laminated name writing sheet we gave you at your home visit.

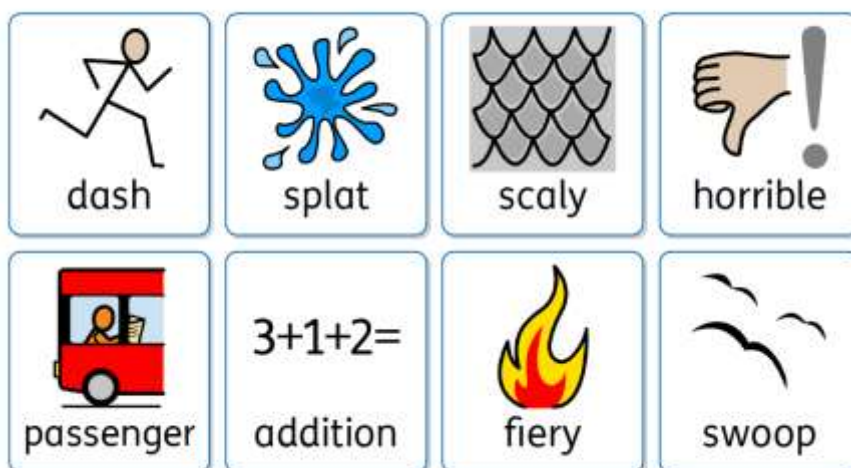
We have used language such as on top, in front, below, behind, in between to describe the position of something. **Can you put your teddy on the pillow? Can you put it under the bed?**
