Stick the flash cards on the wall of your stairs and say them as you go up or down. Or you could put them on your bedroom door to say before opening it.

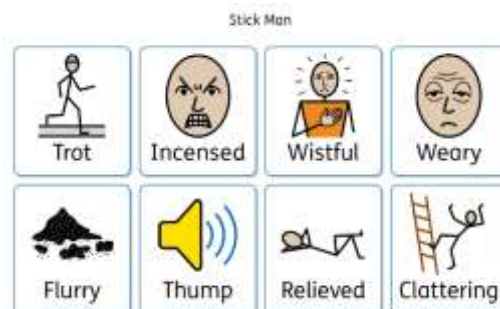
Maths

In maths this week we have been learning about shapes with 4 sides. We have sorted 2D shapes into 2-sided and not 2-sided, we have looked for 4 sided shapes in the classrooms and we have used lolly sticks to make 4 sided shapes.

What do these words mean? Can you show me the action you learnt for the word _____? Encourage your child to use these words at home.

We will be making and writing our own Christmas cards and thinking about the features of cards and letters. In maths we will be consolidating everything we have learnt this term. In Phonics we will continue to recap our letter sounds and harder to read and spell words based on our latest assessments.
