

Science

In Science, we will be recognising that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. Additionally, we will recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents. We will also identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.



Physical Education

PE days: Wednesday and Friday

Basketball (Friday):

In Basketball, we will apply basic principles for attacking and defending and use different skills to keep possession of the ball. We will explore defending principles in game situations, including marking, tracking and covering, to gain possession

Dance (Wednesday):

In Dance, we will explore and practice movement ideas inspired by a stimulus; improvising and combining movement ideas fluently and effectively. We will perform dances in both canon and unison, with clarity and confidence.



PSHE

Our unit for PSHE this half term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will understand why it is important to stretch the boundaries of our current learning and set challenging but realistic goals addressing our steps to success to achieve these.

Religious Education

Our unit this half term is Christianity. We will evaluate different beliefs about eternity and understand the Christian perspective on this. Additionally, we will examine the influences Christianity still has the world and evaluate whether it is still a strong religion.

In Geography, we will begin to understand significant lines of latitude and longitude and compare world biomes. We will learn to understand climate zones and explore and report on key aspects of Galapagos Islands and Madagascar.
