World Book Day

Phonics

In phonics this week we have learnt the harder to read and spell words **said, so, have**. Can you practise writing these words at home on your white boards? Can you find these words in a story book? Don't forget to keep practising all the digraphs and trigraphs we have already learnt. Which ones are you unsure of? You can find these on the stickers in your reading record books.

Maths

This week in maths we have been learning about the numbers 6 and 7. We have thought about ways we can make these numbers, using what we already know. E.g. we know that 2 and 3 makes 5 and we need 1 more to make 6, so we can add 2, 3 and 1 to make 6, or we can add 3 and 3, 2 and 4 etc.

Can you use some of your toys at home to represent ways of making 6 and 7? E.g. 4 teddies and 2 cars. Show us some photos of your arrangements of 6 and 7 on Tapestry.

Dojo challenge!

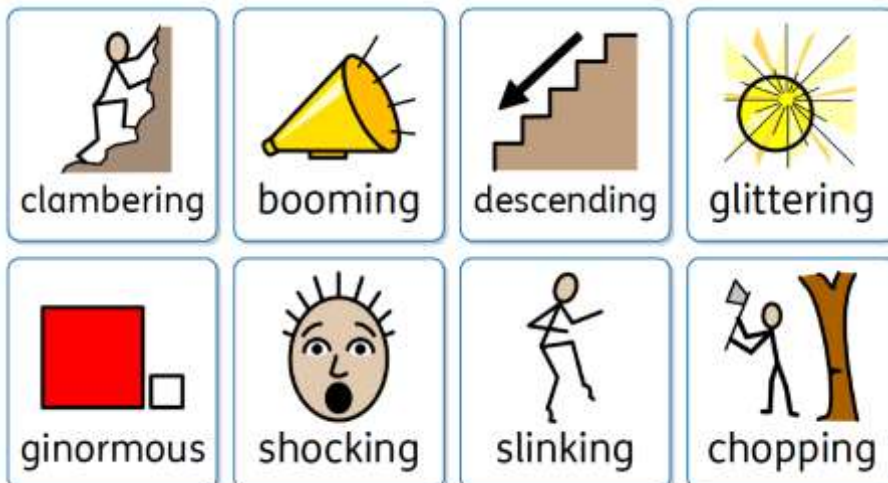
Can you draw and label a picture of yourself? You can add arrows to different parts of your body and use your sounds to write labels for body parts.

Flash card Game idea

Lay the flashcards face down. Roll a small ball over them and see which one it lands on. Turn over the word and read it. If you can read it, you can keep it. If you can't then you must put it back. Take turns with an adult/siblings at home. Whoever has the most cards at the end is the winner!
