Phonics

Can you spot the words or sounds when you are in the supermarket at the weekend?

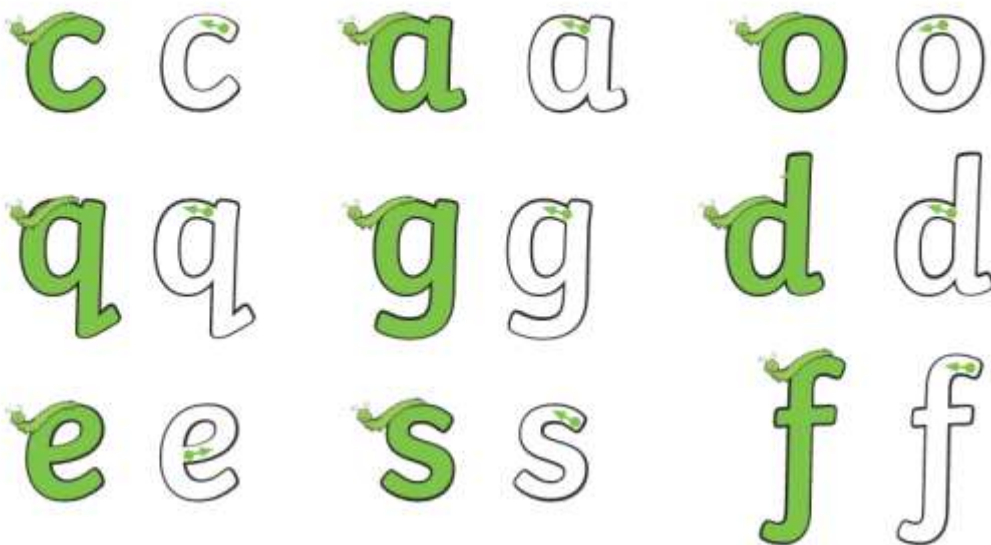
Maths

This week in maths we have been comparing quantities by saying which has more, fewer or if they are equal. We have focused on looking at just the amount rather than colour, shape or size of the objects. We learnt that it doesn't matter if the colour or size is different; it is the amount which we are interested in. **At home can you use some objects to compare; you could have two plates of raisins, or two blankets with objects on for your teddies to compare them. Who has the most? Who has the fewest? Are they an equal amount?**

Curly Caterpillar Letters



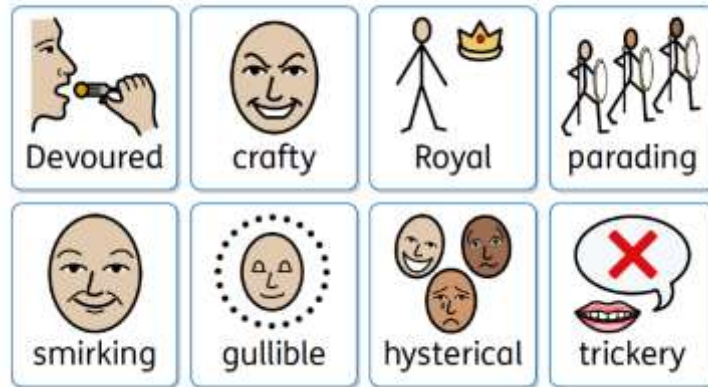
Flash card game idea
