



Talk to Me, Phonics!

Spring 1, Week 5.

This week in phonics, your child has been recapping previously taught sounds and we have focussed on being accurate at recognising digraphs within words. Something we focus on is making sure the digraph is the correct way round and is not reversed, for example 'ra' instead of 'ar'.

Here are some of the sounds that we need to be carefully spotting and their opposite

<u>ar</u>	ra
<u>er</u>	re
<u>ur</u>	ru
<u>ir</u>	ri
