Phonics

This week in phonics we have learnt the harder to read and spell words **some, come, there**. **Have a go at writing these at home and spotting them in your story books.**

We are still recapping the digraphs and trigraphs we have learnt and have been focusing on using these in words in simple sentences. **Have a go at writing a simple sentence using a word with a digraph or trigraph you need to practise; e.g. I like boats. Or, Come to the park.**

Maths

This week we have been learning all about number 7. We have thought about 7 being the 'whole' number, and the different parts that make up 7 e.g. one part of 5 and one part of 2 to make the whole of 7.

Dojo challenge! Sentence writing

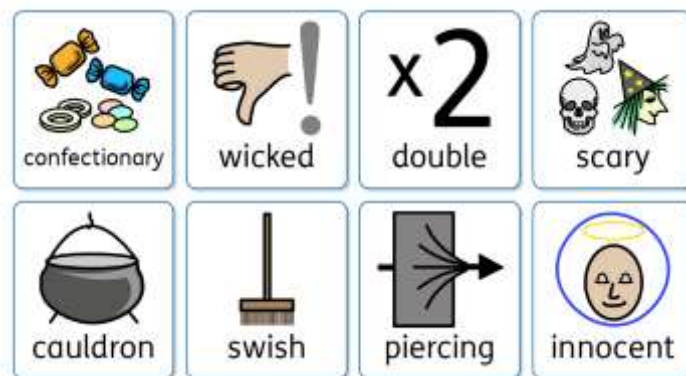
Can you write a simple sentence using finger spaces with some of our harder to read and spell words? Show us some photos on Tapestry.
