Phonics

This week in phonics we have learnt the harder to read and spell words litte, one, do. Have a go at writing these at home on your white boards. Can you find them in a reading book?

We are still focusing on writing simple sentences using finger spaces between words. Can you write a simple sentence using your sound mats and harder to read and spell words mat at home to help you?

Maths

This week we have been learning to understand what a 'double' is. We have used ladybird spots and dice to help us to see that when there are two equal groups, we have a double. Each of the two groups must have the same (equal) number. Can you roll two dice to see if you get a double? How do you know it is/isn't a double?



Dojo challenge! Doubles

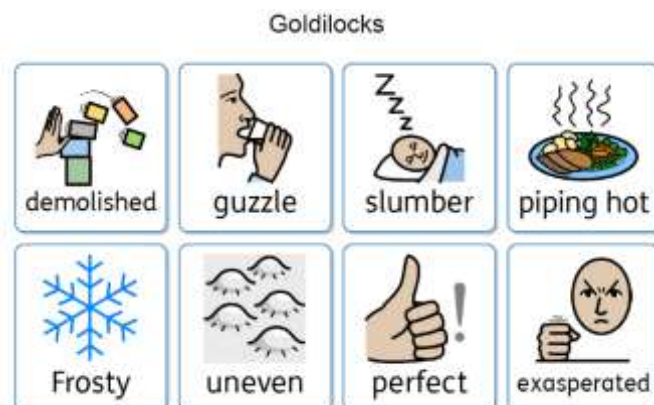
Can you show us a double? Make sure you have two groups that are equal. E.g two equal groups of 3 spoons to make six spoons.
