In maths this week we have been comparing numbers by thinking about where they are in relation to others. We have ordered number blocks to 8 and could see that when you move from 1 to 8, 1 block was added each time. We could see that 5 is 1 more than 4, 7 is one less than 8 etc. **Can you build number blocks towers using Lego or Duplo to show the the number staircase?**

Can you collect some natural objects to make some art?



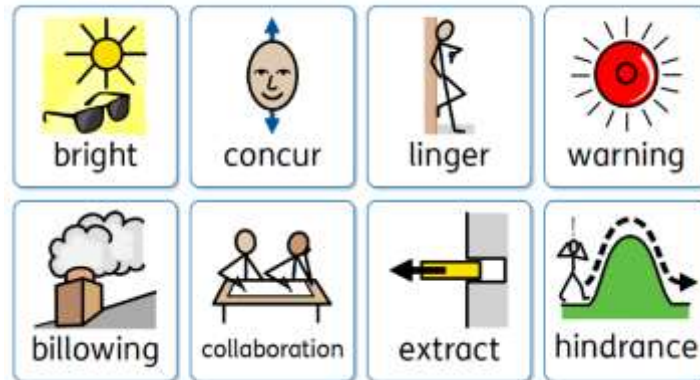
Flash card Game idea
