Phonics

This week in phonics we have continued to look at words that end in 'ed' which make a 't' sound. E.g. brushed. **Can you try writing 'brush' then adding the 'ed' to the end? Now try with dropped, kissed, cooked.**

Maths

This week in maths we have been developing our subitising skills. We have taken groups of objects over 5 and moved them into familiar arrangements. E.g. 6 objects into a dice patterns to show the double 3. We have used tens frames to help us quickly identify the amount of objects rather than counting. **Can you arrange some objects onto your tens frame (in your zippy wallet we gave you)? Can you arrange objects in dice patterns or groups of 2 to help you subitise?**

Dojo challenge!

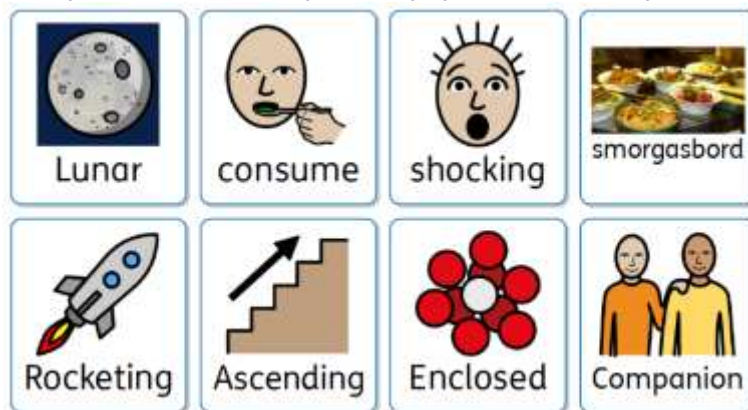
Can you make a trip to the library and choose a book to read? Perhaps one about Space? Can you find some of our harder to read and spell words in the book you have chosen?
