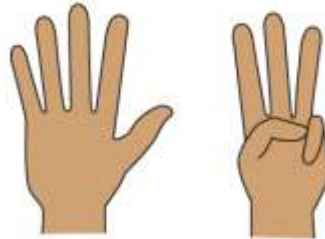
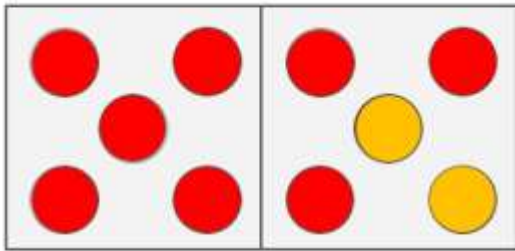

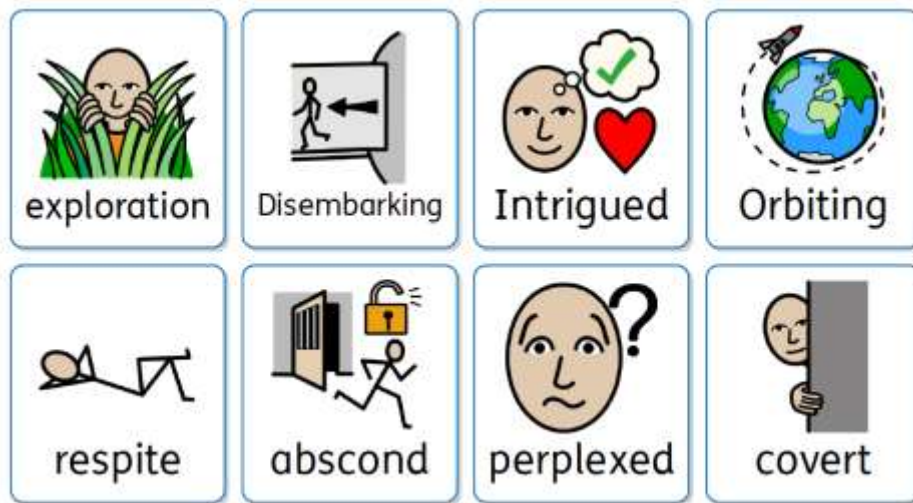
Can you show some ways of making 10 with two sets of objects? E.g 6 grapes + 4 satsumas
