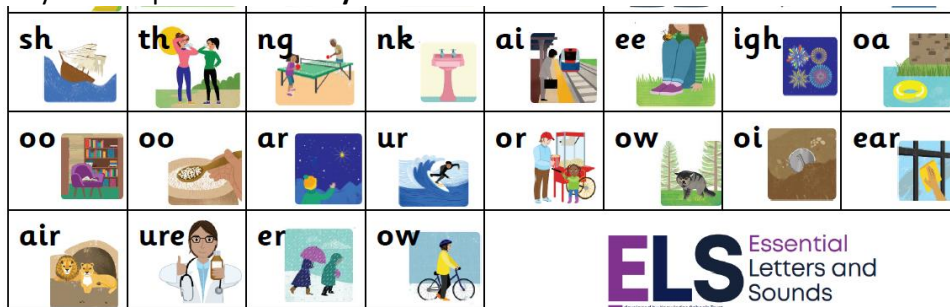


Talk to Me!

You could write them on post it notes and stick them around the house, saying them each time you walk past them. **Can you write some words with these sounds?**



Maths

We have continued using the rekenreks this week with a focus on bonds to 5. We have used the 5 red beads to show ways of making 5; 3 moved to the left, 2 on the right. 4 moved to the left, 1 on the right etc. **Can you show ways of making 5 with some of your toys/pencils?**

We loved your magical bus pictures and sentences! How about you create your own supercar and write something about it? You could even label the different parts of your supercar.

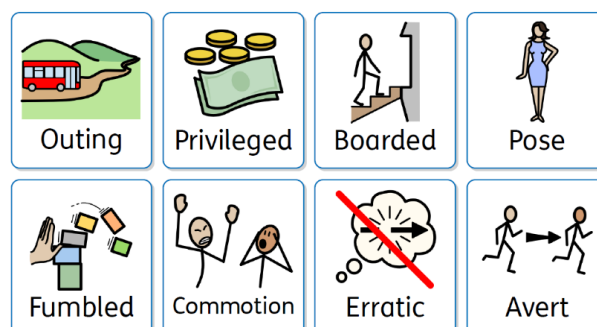
Flash Cards idea
