This week we have been learning about boats. Can you write a few sentences about where you would like to take a boat journey?

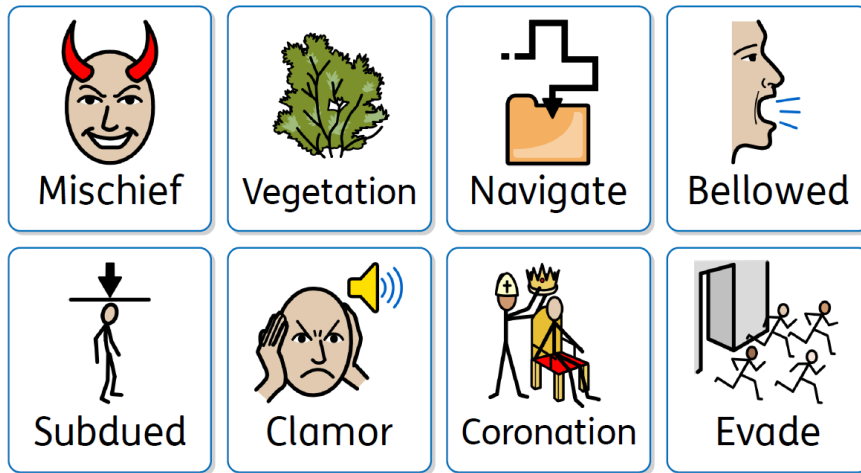
Flash Cards idea
