Phonics

We are recapping all the previous taught digraphs and trigraphs to ensure that we are secure with them all before Year 1. Please have a look through your flash cards at home and just focus on the ones that your child/ren need to practise. You could write them on post it notes and stick them around the house, saying them each time you walk past them. **Can you write some words with these sounds?**



Maths

In Maths we have been exploring 'Rekenreks'. We have been practising our skill of subitising to automatically move the beads across the row, without the need for counting. We have been noticing numbers within the numbers (conceptual subitising) e.g. when moving 6 beads across we can see that 5 are red and 1 is white. Can you draw a picture of a magical bus and write a sentence about it? You could even write a story! Bring them in to show us for a dojo.

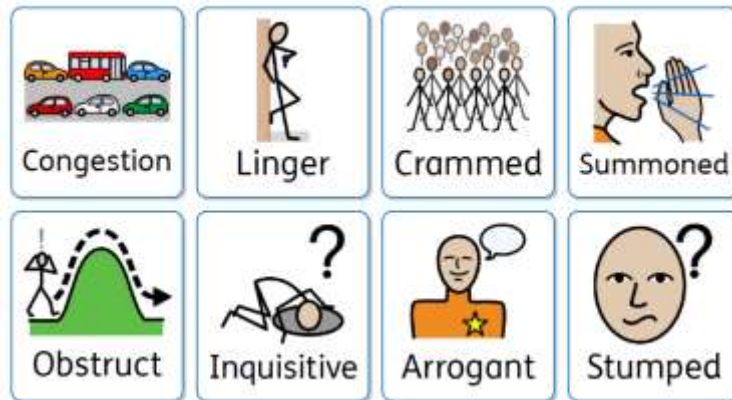
Flash Cards idea
