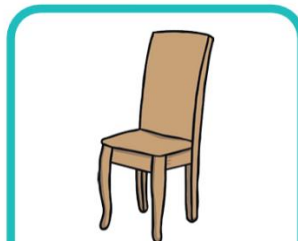

A reminder of our class assembly on Tuesday 7th July at 9am. We look forward to seeing you there.

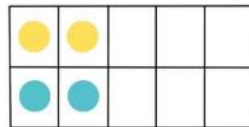
Phonics

We are continuing to consolidate all our learning of the digraphs and trigraphs that we have learnt this year. As we said during Find out Friday last week, lots of children are reversing the digraphs when writing them. Have a go at writing some words that contain the digraphs/trigraphs to check that you are writing them the correct way around e.g. ai, not ia.



Maths

In maths this week we have been looking at patterns within numbers to 10. We have looked at odd and even numbers and double facts. **What doubles can you say? Can all numbers be a double? Do they have to be odd or even to be a double?**



Dojo challenge!

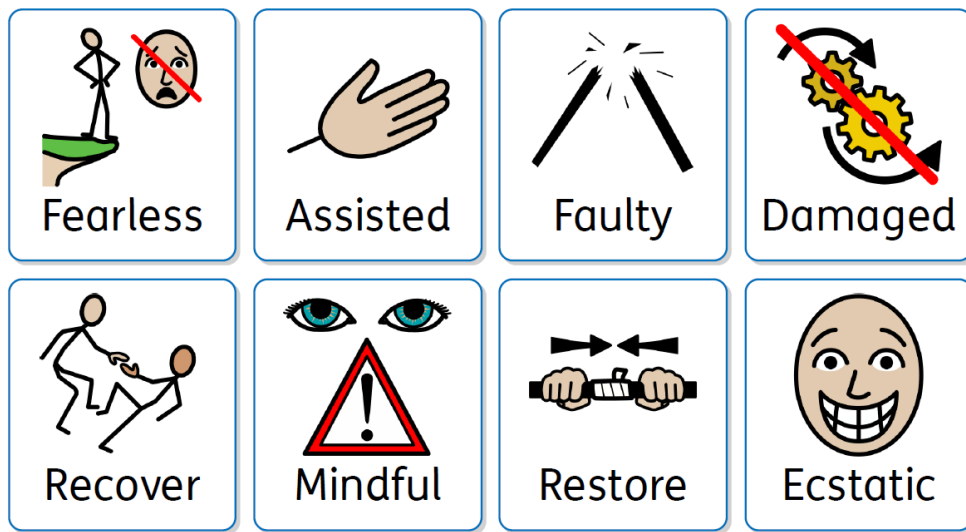
